THE ROTARY CLUB OF HOUMA 2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The scholarship is a one-time payment of \$1,000.00, intended for the 2024 Fall Semester. Payment will be made upon proper proof that recipient has formally registered and been accepted at the intended school, and at the discretion of The Rotary Club of Houma, will be made directly to the school.

Conditions and Eligibility: Senior members of the H.L. Bourgeois High School Interact Club, who plan to attend a four-year college or university, two-year community college or a technical/vocational school in the fall of 2024, may apply. Applicants planning to attend a four-year college or university must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Applicants planning to attend either a two-year community college or a technical/vocational school must meet the entrance requirements for their school of choice. Selection of a recipient shall be the sole discretion of The Rotary Club of Houma, after a careful review of the completed application, essay, recommendations of school administrators and teachers, and any other available information. Consideration will be given to character, community service, leadership, financial need, and academics.
